3 To amend Section 13A-5-5, Code of Alabama 1975,
4 relating to presentence investigation reports; to require that
5 either a presentence or postsentence investigation report be
6 completed and filed on every defendant convicted of a felony
7 offense and filed in an electronic format.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 13A-5-5, Code of Alabama 1975, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "§13A-5-5.


12 "There shall be completed a presentence or
13 postsentence investigation report in all felony cases filed
14 after the effective date of this amendatory act and such
15 report completed and filed on every defendant convicted of a
16 felony offense after the effective date of this amendatory act
17 and such report shall be in an electronic format. On motion of
18 the court or written motion of either party, the court shall
19 require a written report of a presentence investigation of a
20 defendant convicted of a felony, and such defendant shall not
21 be sentenced or otherwise disposed of before such report has
22 been presented to and considered by the court."

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective
24 immediately following its passage and approval by the
25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
